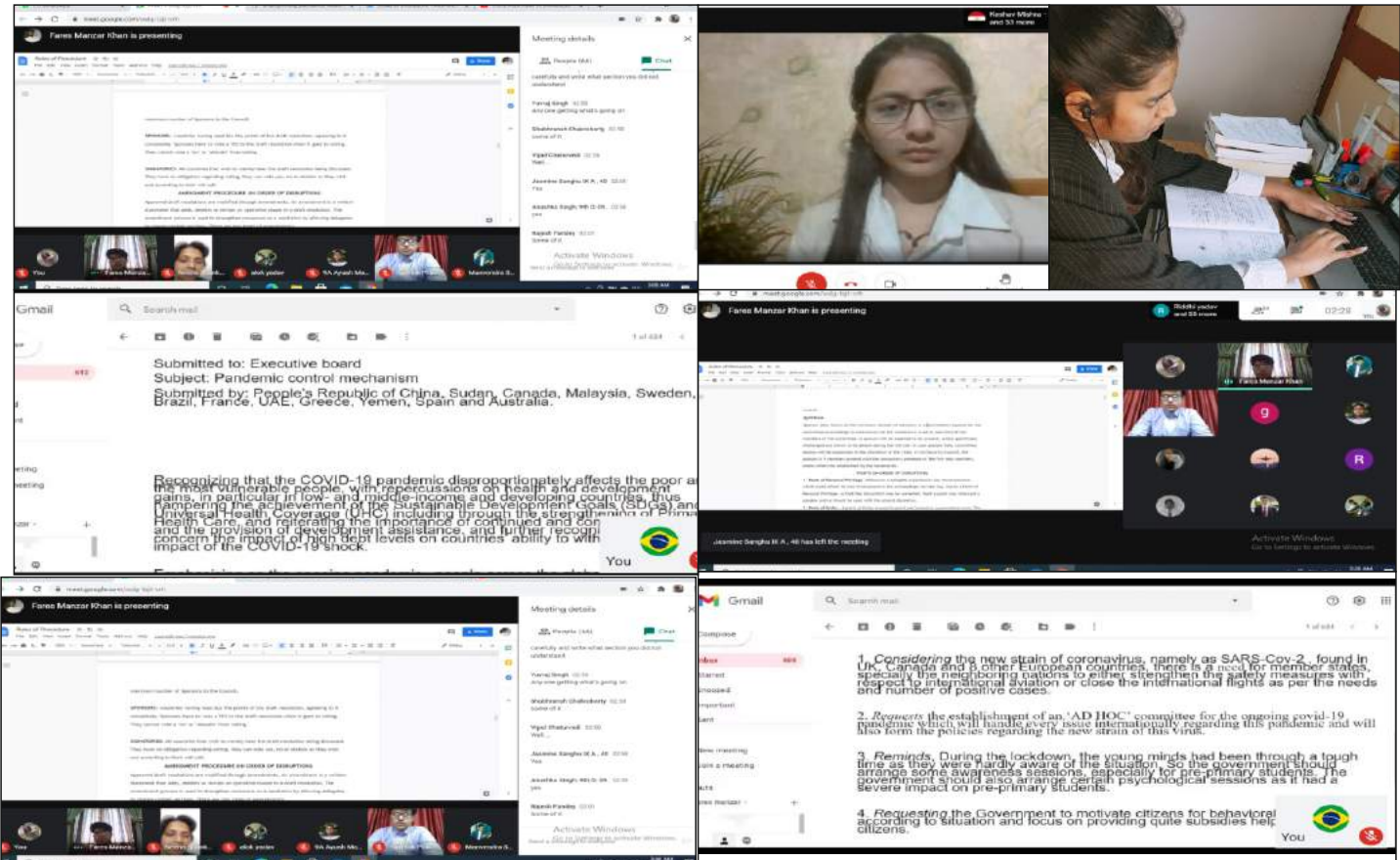




School Events

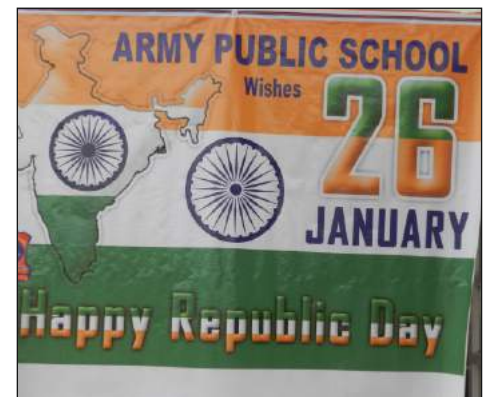

26 January REPUBLIC DAY CELEBRATION

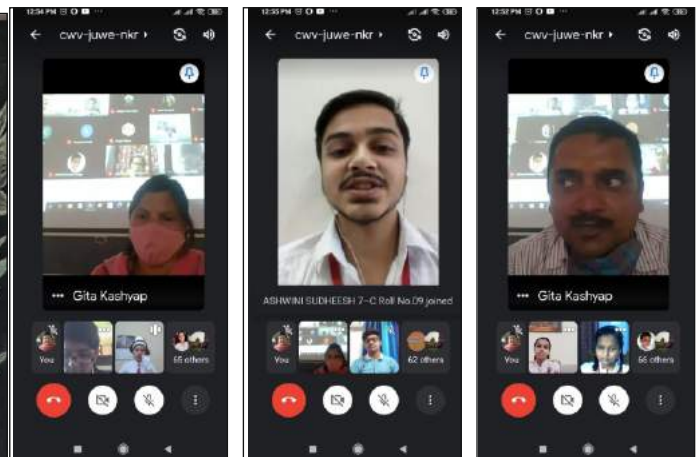

Teachers' Day

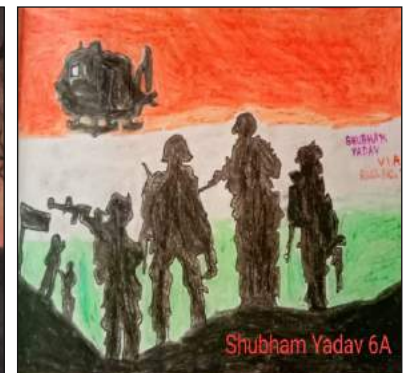

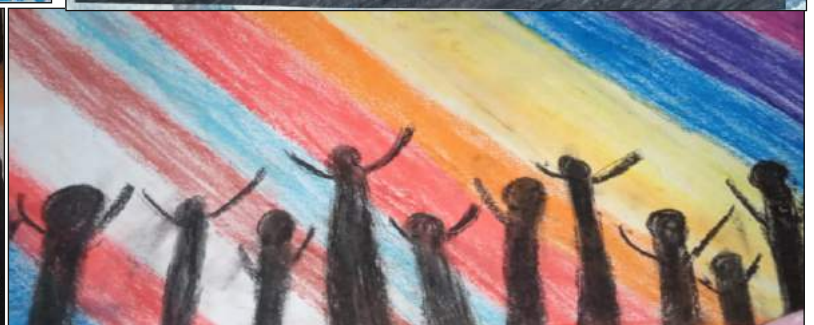
Mahotsava of Ek Bharat Shrestha Bharat

Christmas Celebration

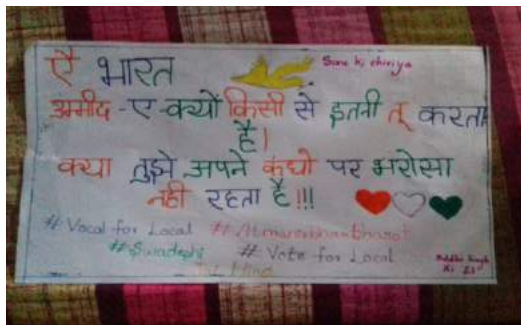

What has been made clear through this pandemic is the importance of disseminating knowledge across borders, companies, and all parts of society. If online learning technology can play a role here, it is incumbent upon all of us to explore its full potential.

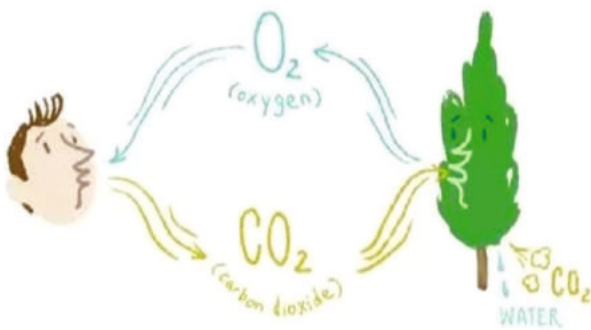

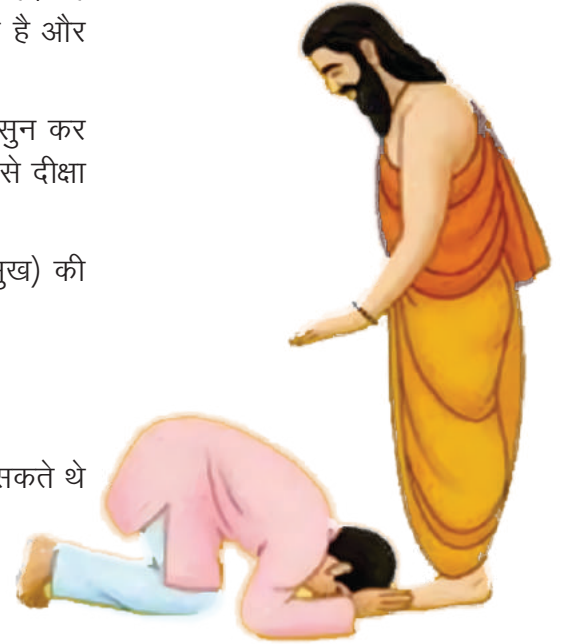
इसलिए कहा गया है कि ———

स्वामी विवेकानंद

जैसा कि हम लोग जानते हैं—

स्वामी विवेकानंद दुनिया के लिए संन्यासी थे, लेकिन संन्यासी होने के बाद जो उन्होंने हमेशा देश के डेवलपमेंट, देश की तरक्की के बारे में सोचा। उन्होंने देश के यूथ (नौजवान) को यह सोचने के लिए मजबूर कर दिया कि कैसे वो अपने अंदर के छुपे पोटेंशियल को बाहर निकाल सकते हैं?

मैं दो बातें उनके लाइफ में से आपके साथ शेयर करना चाहती हूँ, जिससे हम कुछ सीखकर हम खुद को कुछ आगे बढ़ा पाएं।

- ★ पहली चीज जो मैंने उनके जिंदगी से सीखी वो है (BE Fearless) स्वामी विवेकानन्द जी बचपन से किसी बात को सुनकर नहीं मानते थे, वो उसको खुद देख कर खुद एक्सपीरियंस करके मानते थे। बचपन में वे अपने दोस्त के साथ उसके बगीचे में खेलने जाते थे, और हमेशा एक पेड़ पर चढ़ जाते थे। अब उन दोनों बच्चों को चोट नहीं लग जाए इसलिए बच्चे के दादा जी ने कहा— इस पेड़ पर भूत रहता है, और पेड़ पर चढ़ने वालों की गर्दन तोड़ देता है। उनका दोस्त यह बात सुनकर घबरा गया लेकिन विवेकानंद जी बिल्कुल नहीं घबराये। उन्होंने तय कर लिया कि वह इस बात की पूरी सच्चाई जानकर रहेंगे। इसलिए एक रात वह चुपचाप उस पेड़ पर चढ़ गए और पूरी रात इंतजार किया कि कोई भूत आता है या नहीं। जब पूरी रात कोई भूत नहीं आया तो उन्होंने अपने दोस्त को कहा कि “यहाँ कोई भूत नहीं है” मैंने खुद देखा है।
- ★ दोस्तों, उनका मानना था कि डर ही इंसान का सबसे बड़ा दुश्मन है जो उसे आगे बढ़ने से रोकता है। इसलिए उन्होंने कहा था.. अगर पाप जैसी कोई चीज है तो यह कहना एक मात्र पाप है कि “मैं कमजोर हूँ या कोई और कमजोर है”।
- ★ उनके जीवन में से दूसरी बात जो हमें बहुत कुछ सिखा सकती है वो है (Believe in Yourself) “खुद पर विश्वास” स्वामी विवेकानंद का मानना था कि “अगर किसी मकसद के लिए खड़े हो, तो पेड़ की तरह खड़े हो, गिरो तो बीज की तरह गिरो ताकि फिर से मिट्टी में उगकर दोबारा अपने मकसद को जी पाओ”। अपने गुरु के दिए हुए ज्ञान को पूरी दुनिया में फैलाना ही स्वामी विवेकानंद का मकसद था और इसे पूरा करने में वह जीवन भर लगे रहे। उनका मकसद था कि पूरी दुनिया में इंडिया के ज्ञान को फैलाना है। दोस्तों, स्वामी विवेकानंद को खुद पर हद से ज्यादा विश्वास था और दोस्तों खुद पर विश्वास करना बहुत बड़ी ताकत होती है। उन्होंने फैसला किया कि १८८३ में शिकागो में होने वाले विश्व धर्म सम्मेलन यानी कि “पार्लियामेंट ऑफ द वर्ल्ड्स रिलीजन में वो हिस्सा लेंगे। शिकागो पहुँचते ही स्वामी जी को एक बहुत बड़ी चुनौती आ गयी कि ‘पार्लियामेंट ऑफ द वर्ल्ड्स रिलीजन’ 2 महीने आगे बढ़ चुका था।
- ★ अब स्वामी जी के पास इतने पैसे नहीं थे कि वो शिकागो में 2 महीने गुजार सकें। तो उन्होंने कई रातें सड़कों पर गुजारी, कई बार भूखे पेट सोये। स्वामी जी की अलग ड्रेसिंग स्टाइल की वजह से लोग उनका मजाक बनाते, कई बार तो कुछ लोग उन्हें मारने तक दौड़ते। लेकिन फिर भी स्वामी जी कभी भी कमजोर नहीं पड़े, कभी भी घुटने नहीं टेके, वक्त से कभी भी नहीं हारे, क्यों कि उनका लक्ष्य बहुत बड़ा था, कि देश को, भारत को विश्व के मंच पर वो सम्मान दिलाना है जो वह (Deserve) करता है और हुआ भी ऐसा ही। विश्व धर्म सम्मेलन के मंच पर उन्होंने ऐसा भाषण दिया कि सुनने वालों को हिंदुस्तान और हिंदुस्तान की महान संत पर फक्र होने लगा। पूरी दुनिया में वह स्पीच इतनी प्रसिद्ध हुई कि आज भी लोग उस स्पीच को पढ़ते और सुनते हैं। इतनी महान स्पीच थी वह।

जरूरी बात— स्वामी विवेकानंद ने सिद्ध कर दिया कि अगर खुद पर अटूट विश्वास हो तो दुनिया की बड़ी से बड़ी ताकत भी तुम्हें रोक नहीं सकती तुम्हारे मकसद को पाने से। आपके पास दीया है, आपके पास बाती है, आपके पास तेल भी है लेकिन फिर भी आप उस दीये को नहीं जला पाओगे क्योंकि उसे जलाने के लिए चाहिए चिंगारी। इसी तरह आपके पास प्लांस, आइडियाज, रिसोर्स, स्किल्स है लेकिन विश्वास की चिंगारी नहीं होगी तो प्लांस, आइडियाज, रिसोर्स, स्किल्स सब कुछ बर्बाद है। इसलिए खुद पर भरोसा जरूरी है। अगर खुद पर भरोसा करोगे तभी खुदा (भगवान) भी तुम पर भरोसा करेगा।

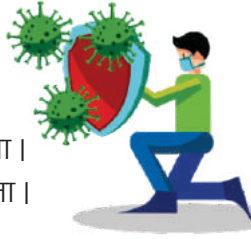

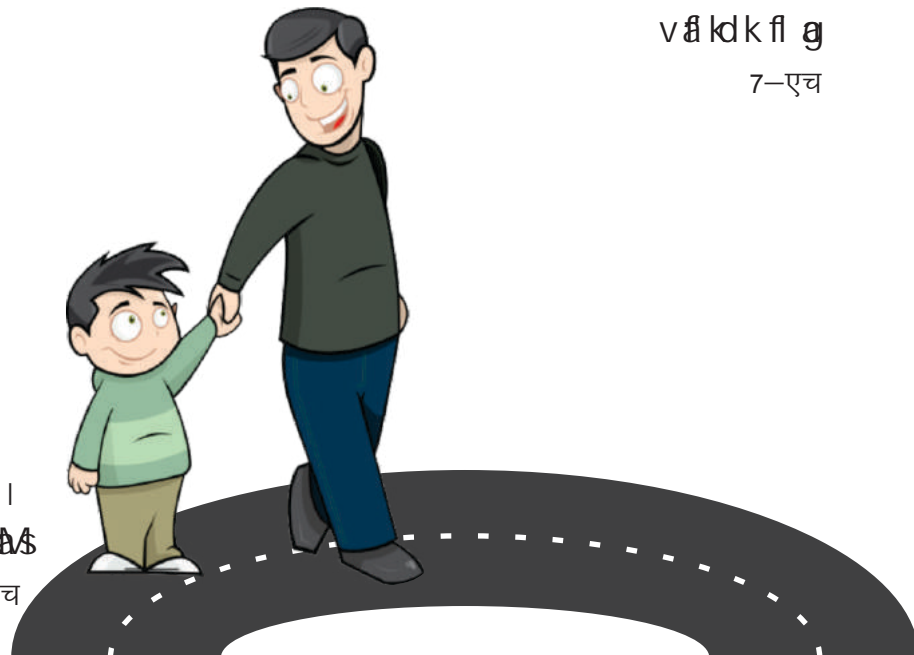

It was a great honor to be sworn as the head girl of Army Public School, Prayagraj for the session 2020 - 21. Serving the

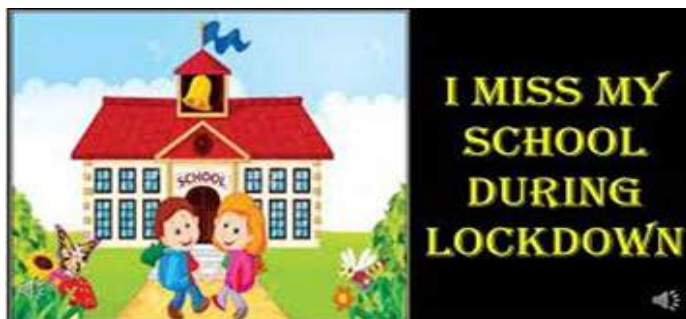
