

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS FOR TEACHERS IN ARMY PUBLIC SCHOOLS

(a) **Qualification Criteria.** The requisite qualifications are as under:-

(i) In addition to the minimum aggregate percentage mentioned in the table above, a candidate should have scored no less than 50% marks in each of the subjects in which they have graduated/ post- graduated. Detailed mark sheets will be scrutinized during the interview.

(ii) *A Post-Graduate with less than 50% aggregate marks in Graduation can also apply for the post of a TGT / PRT, provided the candidate has scored a minimum of 50% or more aggregate marks in Post-Graduation.

(b) CTET / TET conducted by Centre / State government is **mandatory for appointment as TGTs FIXED TERM** category.

(c) Aggregate percentage will be based on the marks for the entire duration of Graduation/Post Graduation.

2. **Age and Experience Criteria of Candidates.** As on 01 April of the year of appointment, the age and experience of the candidates and weightage to Army Spouses should be as under: -
